As you know, the EPO is a member of the so-called "Tegernsee Group", which is engaged in work of a fact-finding nature focused on substantive patent law harmonization. Last year, the Tegernsee Expert Group was requested to carry out four studies on (1) Grace period, (2) 18-Month Publication, (3) Treatment of Conflicting Applications, and (4) Prior User Rights.
